And _____ surety (sureties) is held and firmly bound unto the Sanitation District No. 1 (District), in the sum of Six Thousand, Three Hundred Thirty-Eight and 00/100 Dollars (\$6,338.00): for the payment of which we hereby jointly and severally bind ourselves and our legal representatives.

Sealed with our seals and dated at Ft. Wright, Kentucky this ____ day of _____, 20_____.

The condition of the above obligation is such that, whereas, the above named principal has made application to the District for a license as a sewer tapper to be renewed annually, to carry on the business, undertake the employment and do the work of tapping and making connections with the public sewers and drains of the District and of building for private use such lateral drains, with approved fixtures and laterals to connect therewith, as the District might from time to time authorize in each particular case to be made in accordance with applicable District Rules and Regulations and in compliance with Federal, State and local safety laws and regulations.

Now, if the said principal shall well, faithfully and in a workmanlike and timely manner, make and complete all its taps and connections with the public sewers and drains of the District and all its District approved lateral drains with necessary fixtures, and if the said principal shall indemnify and save the District harmless from all loss or damage that may be occasioned in any wise by accident of the want of care or skill on his part in the prosecution of such work, or that may be occasioned by reason of any opening by him made or caused to be made in any street, lane, avenue, market place or common, in the making of any connections with any public or

private sewer as foresaid;

And further, if said principal shall conform in all respects to the Rules and Regulations of all governmental agencies and the District which may from time to time be established in relation to the putting in of junctions and tapping of any public sewers and drains, then this obligation shall be null and of no effect, otherwise of full force and virtue.

However, should the principal fail to adhere to any of the above obligations (a Breach), the existence of such Breach to be reasonably determined by the District in its sole discretion, the District shall notify the principal and the surety of such Breach in writing (Notice). Within a reasonable amount of time after receiving the Notice, the principal and/or the surety shall correct the Breach, or the surety and the District shall agree on the amount of bond proceeds necessary to correct the Breach and the surety shall tender payment of such amount to the District. If the principal and/or surety fail to correct the Breach or the surety fails to tender the bond proceeds necessary to correct the Breach within a reasonable amount of time, the principal and surety shall be deemed to be in default on this bond and the District shall thereafter be entitled to enforce any remedy available to it.

This bond shall begin _____, 20____, and continue until canceled. This bond may be canceled as to future liability by the surety upon thirty (30) days written notice to the District at 1045 Eaton Drive, Ft. Wright, KY 41017. Any such cancellation shall release the surety from liability for any subsequent acts of the principal; provided, however, the surety shall remain liable for any and all acts of the principal covered by this bond up to the date of cancellation.
